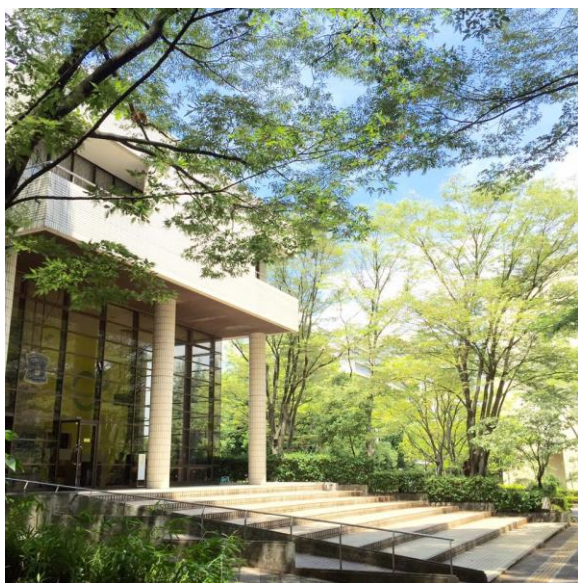
## Library



The mission of the university library is to support students and staff in all areas of their study and research. The library provides student-centered learning environment and access to a wide range of information resources.

Display of works and a message from the Nobel Prize winner, Prof. Takaaki Kajita, an alumnus of the university, are on display in the library.

## University Hall



The University Hall offers a wide range of services and events to students, faculty, staff and the community. It has social facilities such as learning spaces, meeting rooms and Japanese style rooms. On the first floor, there are plenty of areas to relax- there is a convenience store with indoor and outdoor dining areas.

## International House



The International House provides 152 rooms for international students and 20 rooms for researchers. Type of rooms are; single room, couple room and family room. It is located within walking distance of classrooms and campus services.

### Facilities in Individual Room

Each room is furnished with bath/shower, bed, desk, chair, bookshelf, closet, refrigerator, kitchen, air conditioner and shoe cabinet. Free Wi-Fi internet access is available for the residents.
