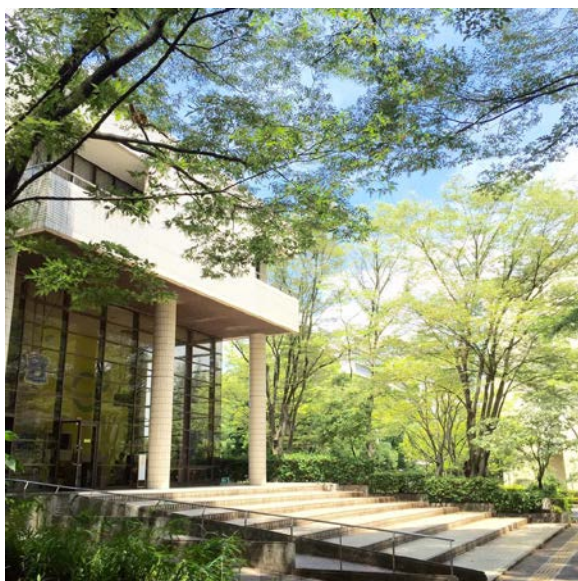
Library



The mission of the university library is to support students and staff in all areas of their study and research. The library provides student-centered learning environment and access to a wide range of information resources.

University Hall



The University Hall offers a wide range of services and events to students, faculty, staff and the community. It has social facilities such as learning spaces, meeting rooms and Japanese style rooms. On the first floor, there are plenty of areas to relax- there is a convenience store with indoor and outdoor dining areas.

International House



The International House provides 152 rooms for international students and 20 rooms for researchers. Type of rooms are; single room, couple room and family room. It is located within walking distance of classrooms and campus services.

Each room is furnished with bath/shower, bed, desk, chair, bookshelf, closet, refrigerator, kitchen, air conditioner and shoe cabinet. Free Wi-Fi internet access is available for the residents.

Sports Facilities

Students are encouraged to actively engage in extracurricular activities. On-campus sports facilities include gymnastic halls, martial arts hall and the Japanese-archery Field. In addition, there are outdoor facilities such as athletic fields, soccer fields, baseball fields, rugby fields, tennis courts fully equipped with night game utilities, and a swimming pool.
