Qualifications and conditions:

1. (1) Graduate level (Acceptable number: 4)
Regular students and research student of Saitama University.
(2) Undergraduate level (Acceptable number: 1)
Regular students of Saitama University.
2. Status of residence is or to be changed to "Student"
3. Students should meet the required GPA in the previous academic year more than 2.3 on a 3.0 scale.
Except newly enrolled students. It might be based on "個別成績表" from the web system.
(3=S+/S/A+/A/A-, 2=B+/B/B-, 1=C+/C/C+, 0=F)
4. Monthly allowance from your family should not exceed ¥90,000.
5. The annual income of your financial supporter residing in Japan may not exceed ¥5,000,000.
6. Students do not receive a scholarship from another institution that does not allow plural grants of the Honors Scholarship
7. Students do not receive scholarship for Short-term Study in Japan (Student Exchange Support Program) by Jasso
8. Students should meet the required language ability of Japanese or English as follows.
Ex.) JLPT level higher than N2, EJU points higher than 200, CEFR level higher than B2

- ② Application form in Japanese (1 sheet)
- ③ A photocopy of Student ID Card and Residence Card (Two sides of each card)
- ④ An academic Transcript (Print out from Web System. Except newly enrolled students)
- ⑤ A photocopy of Japan Post Bank passbook which Code, Number and your Name are printed on.
(If it does not have Katakana name, please submit a photocopy of your bank card too)
- ⑥ A certificate of Language Proficiency (English or Japanese)
