

## Some examples to promote SDGs Activities by Saitama University

### 1. Lecture about SDGs at Saitama University

- (1) June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2016 Public Relations Officer of Japan Center, United Nations Information Center (UNIC) gave a lecture on newly introduced SDGs to Saitama University undergraduate students.
