Non-Japanese, non-permanent resident who will be enrolled in the following years of the degree program in Saitama University as of April, 2025: • Undergraduate : 3rd or 4th year • Master's : 1st or 2nd year • Doctoral : 2nd or 3rd year 2. Self-financed students with "Student" Visa status (Other Visa status holders may apply under the circumstance of changing the Visa Status to "Student" after being accepted by the foundation) 3. Born after April 2, 1980 (age under 45)
Eligibility Requirements	 <u>The following are ineligible</u>: Former recipients of Rotary Yoneyama Scholarship Holders of scholarships from any other scholarship program for the duration of the Rotary Scholarship. (Tuition Exemption from the university may not be subject to this limitation.) Those who plan to leave Japan or take a leave of absence from school that exceeds the number of days of limitation set by the foundation. An overview is provided below, but please refer to the applicaton guideline for detail. The total period of time allowed to leave Japan is 60 days per year but if the supervisor approves the need, a total of 90 days will be allowed.
Application Period	-To study abroad for a short period of time, you may take a leave of absence for up to 185 days within the scholarship period. Eligible applicants may submit the necessary documents to the Office of International

Selection Criteria	 [University Criteria] Applicant's transcript records, financial situation, quality of written essays etc. Applicant's Japanese proficiency *University will hold interviews as a pre-screening process to the students who are enrolled in programs that award academic degrees in English. [Foundation Criteria] Those who are interested in the activities of Rotary, and willing to cooperate with the members of the foundation Those who are able to communicate in Japanese(All interviews and activities at the foundation are conducted in Japanese) * If you are unsure about the Japanese proficiency and would like to know about your qualication, it is strongly suggested to consult with our office prior to your application. You may also consult with Prof. Nakamoto (International Student Advisor) to receive any kind or advise regarding your Japanese proficiency.

Current SU students who have not yet taken the entrance exam must declare the date of submission.

University will hold interviews as a pre-screening process to the students who are enrolled in programs that award academic degrees in English. Applicant in this subject will be invited to a zoom interview when a confirmation mail is sent. You must reply within 24 hours to schedule an appointment. Failing to attend the interview will make the application incomplete, thus will not be considered. Result of the screening will be announced via E-mail. Selected nominees must reply within 24 hours after the notice of selection in order to receive further instructions. Anyone who fails to reply by the deadline will be considered as to be declined. Submission by e-mail will be permitted ONLY for SU Students being away from Japan. Please follow the instruction below. Prospective students who are not living in Japan at the time of application are not eligible to apply Scan ALL the documents in PDF file. Attach the soft copy to the mail and send it to the Office of International Affairs : ryugaku@grsaitam=u.a.gip *\$tudent1D may be sent by photo, but must be attached along with the other documents (do NOT paste the photo directly to the mail).
