I . General Information

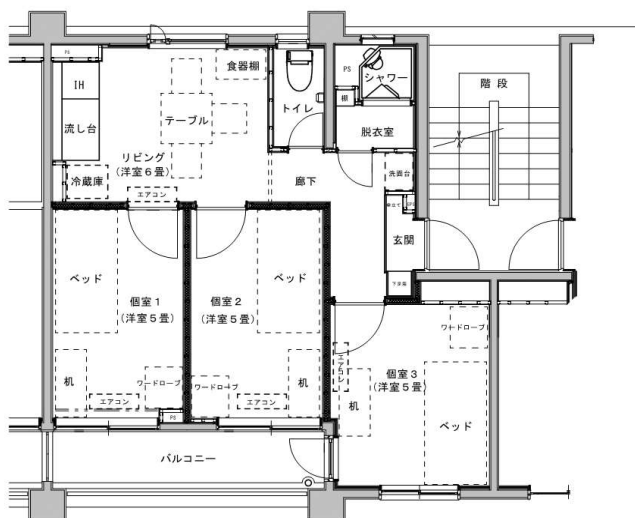
STEPS students are assigned to 4th Building only, which features shared rooms for three people.

If you wish to live in a single room, please arrange private apartment accommodation off campus by yourself. We believe that the shared room arrangement is a special opportunity for all of you to meet and share cultural experiences among students from different backgrounds.

Room assignments will be determined by the university based on the gender listed on your passport. We cannot accommodate any requests regarding assigned roommates or room locations. Please note that once the room allocation has been made, we cannot accept any requests for room changes under any circumstances. Please understand this before applying.

III. Period of Stay

Date of moving-in: April 1 (Wed) - 3 (Fri), 2026

Date of moving-out: July 31 (Fri), 2026 (for 2-terms students) / February 15 (Wed), 2027 (for 4-terms students)

IV. Rent Fee

Rent (Monthly) 30,500 yen, ※1,

※2: Nonrefundable. It is offset by the bedding set and room cleaning fee. The exact amount will be notified separately.

V. Payment

Lump-sum payment is required for students who do not receive JASSO scholarships. Students expecting to receive JASSO scholarships after arriving in Japan may arrange monthly payments.

The total amount for the lump-sum payment will be notified separately once the deposit amount is confirmed.

1. Lump-sum payment

You can pay your accommodation fees through online payment system Flywire. You can use a credit card and pay in your currency. STEPS students who are going to study for 4 terms will be asked to pay the remaining fees in August 2026.

2. Payment by bank transfer

Payment should be made at Japan Post Bank (ゆうちょ銀行). You can only pay in cash. Billing statements will be issued via email. Please pay the amount by the designated date.
