## 1. Program outline

SU Language Exchange Fair is a program in which Japanese students and international students teach each other's languages in Japanese or their mother language and talk about casual daily conversations and topics you're interested in.

This allows you to learn "living language" that you cannot learn in class, improve your language skills, and promote intercultural understanding.
