To this end, Saitama City and 8 other regional government bodies (Saitama Prefecture, Chiba Prefecture, Tokyo Metropolis, Kanagawa Prefecture, Yokohama City, Kawasaki City, Chiba City, and Sagami-hara City) each hold a Joint Inter-Prefectural and Municipal Disaster Drill every year, to help promote and strengthen the abilities of residents and workplaces to provide self-help and mutual aid.

Fire Drills

Learn how to put out a fire with a fire extinguisher.



Earthquake Simulator

Take a ride in an earthquake simulator, stay calm and brace yourself.



Smoke Tent

Learn how to move to a safe area while trying not to inhale smoke.



Drill Demonstrations

Observe life-saving drills performed by participating organizations.



Emergency First-Aid Workshop

Be prepared for emergency situations. Learn and practice how to perform CPR, etc.
